



## Farewell Bend Park Information Sheet For Community Events

Thank you for considering a Bend Park & Recreation District park for your community event. This information sheet is intended to provide you with details about the park. The Event Guidelines provide you with general park use information. Should you have questions, please don't hesitate to call the district at 389-7275.

### PARK AVAILABILITY:

The event season is May 1 through October 15; some exceptions may be made.

### HOURS:

Park hours are 5:00 am – 10:00 pm

### EVENTS PER MONTH:

A maximum of two (2) event days each month can be scheduled. In most situations, only one reserved activity is allowed in any given park at one time. Shelters may be reserved as often as twice a day.

### CAPACITY:

- This park has 1.6 acres of turf area conducive to special events
- Capacity is dependent on event features, layout, activities and traffic flow and impact to the park.
- Large shelter capacity: 36 seats; south shelter 16 seats; north shelter 16 seats
- Larger events may reserve the shelter and extend into the park.
- This park is very busy with general public use, trail and water access during the summer months. Allowances need to be made for general public access.

### PARKING/VEHICLES:

- There are 44 parking spaces at this park.
- Events at Farewell Bend will require off site parking and a shuttle plan
- Parking may be available across the river at Riverbend Park dependent on other park uses.
- Agreements with adjacent property owners for additional parking may be made by the event organizer.
- Event visitors must be informed on allowable parking locations.
- There is NO vehicle access onto park land.

### AMPLIFIED SOUND and NOISE

- Farewell Bend Park is suitable for non-amplified music. Proposals for amplified music must be submitted for approval prior to booking. If approved, sound levels shall not exceed 65 decibels at the mix station.
- Event organizers must comply with City of Bend noise ordinances. (Bend Code 5.385) Should amplified sound be approved, it may not begin prior to 7:00 am and must end no later than 10:00 pm. This includes sound test and set up.

**AMENITIES:**

- There are four permanent restrooms at the park.
- 20 amp electricity and potable water
- ADA access

**ADA:**

Event organizers should contact City of Bend Accessibility Manager at 693-2141 to determine regulations and strategies for making events accessible to people of all abilities.

**SET UP/TAKE DOWN:**

Set up and start time will be determined at the pre-event meeting with the district event team. Event organizer needs to be present for set up and take down.

**DOGS:**

Dogs are not allowed at special events; the event organizer must post appropriate signage and enforce according to City of Bend Special Event Guidelines.

Any variance to these park use conditions must be pre-approved by Bend Park and Recreation District
