Sylvan Park Playground Renovation Project Community Survey Summary & Data

Why is this project happening?

After being built in 1993, the current playground has aged and no longer meets the needs of the growing neighborhood. This project will replace the playground and fall surfacing, update park furnishings, and improve accessibility to the playground with a new route from the parking area.

To ensure the new playground reflects community needs and priorities, BPRD conducted a public survey in January 2025. Neighbors were notified by mail, email and word of mouth, and encouraged to provide input to help shape the design. The following is a summary of the survey results. If you would like to review the results of the survey in their entirety, please find that information at the end of this document.

Who participated?

A broad range of community members responded, with the largest age groups being 35-44 and 65+ years old. Many respondents currently use the park, though some noted that the playground is outdated and primarily suited for younger children.

How did people hear about the survey?

Most participants (57%) learned about the survey through mailed postcards, making it the most effective outreach method.

What types of play should the new playground offer?

The two most popular types of play desired are climbing and swinging. Many respondents emphasized the need for features that cater to a wider range of ages, including older children.

What materials should be used?

Respondents preferred natural materials, such as wood, over plastic, metal and concrete, or a combination of materials. Many emphasize durability, sustainability, and aesthetics that blend with the park's environment.

What should the playground look like?

An overwhelming 87% of respondents preferred a nature-inspired color palette, favoring muted tones that complement the park's natural setting.

What features could improve the enjoyment of the play area for all?

Commonly suggested improvements included:

 More swings and climbing structures for all age groups, with sliding and balancing coming in next in terms of popularity.

- Seating and picnic areas for families and seniors
- A portable restroom like other neighborhood parks have
- ADA-compliant play opportunities to ensure a welcoming atmosphere
- A safer, more durable play surface instead of wood chips

What activities do people enjoy at Sylvan Park?

The most popular activities included walking (64%), observing nature (47%), playing (41%), and gathering with family and friends (26%). Open space is highly valued, with many requesting that it be preserved.

Additional feedback from the community:

Survey participants strongly supported the renovation and provided a variety of suggestions:

- Many want the playground to maintain its natural feel.
- Several emphasized keeping open grassy areas for informal play and relaxation.
- Many expressed desires for more seating options through benches and picnic tables.
- A few respondents expressed concerns about potential overdevelopment and the need to maintain the park's quiet character.
- Some respondents requested that pickleball courts and/or a designated off-leash area be
 considered as part of this project. Due to the specific scope of this project, constraints of the
 site and BPRD's Development Standards for Neighborhood Parks, these amenities will not be
 included in the project's conceptual designs.

Next Steps


BPRD is using this valuable feedback to develop multiple playground design concepts that reflect the community's priorities. These concepts will aim to create a fun, accessible, and site appropriate play space that serves residents of all ages while preserving the park's natural beauty.

The second round of public outreach will begin this spring, with notifications being sent out by both email and mailers. The neighborhood will have the opportunity to review each of the playground concepts, provide the design team feedback and help determine the direction for the renovated space.




Q3 Whether you currently use the playground or not, what types of play would you most like to see featured in the new playground? (please select your top two choices)






