

DRAKE PARK RENTAL GUIDELINES

Thank you for considering Drake Park for your event. The information below provides you with specific details for the use of Drake Park.

Amenities

- Four acres of turf allowed for public event use.
- The amphitheater is 70 feet wide by 40 feet deep at the widest part of the stage. Specific dimensions are provided upon request.
- 50-amp electrical services located behind the amphitheater and at the south end of the event space near the pump house.
- Potable water access located behind the amphitheater and near the pump house.
- Concrete portable restroom pad for up to approximately 4 units (includes one ADA unit).

Amplified Noise

Per district policy, amplified sound may begin no earlier than 10:00 am (vs. 7:00 am per City of Bend (COB) ordinance) and must end at 9:00 pm Sunday – Thursday and 10:00 pm Friday – Saturday. This includes sound check and setup.

Drake Park Footbridge

The footbridge between Drake Park and Pageant Park is limited to 20 people on the bridge at one time. For events that will impact the use of the footbridge, Renter must post trail warning signage at least seven days prior to the event alerting the public of the heavy use. During Use, Renter must coordinate a staff or volunteer at either end of the footbridge to monitor the number of people on the bridge.

Irrigation

Due to the reoccurring annual water shortage, we cannot guarantee irrigation will be operating through the end of the event season. If irrigation is shut off early due to low water levels, event setup may need to be reduced or altered to be on hard surfaces. Inflatables, food trucks, and other items that cause an impact to the turf will be prohibited.

Parking/Vehicles

- Parking is available on Riverside Blvd. and is not exclusive to events. Contact Diamond Parking to reserve parking spaces. Event organizers must also coordinate their parking plan with the City of Bend using the Event Parking Toolkit.
- Contact Bend La Pine School District for possible use of the Highland School parking lot.
- Parking vehicles and set up of any kind behind the amphitheater is prohibited due to tree root compaction.
- Vehicle access to park grounds require paid fees and pre-approval by the district.

Marine Board Permit

A Marine Event Permit must be submitted if Deschutes River is used during the event.

Any variance from the park use conditions must be pre-approved by Bend Park and Recreation District.
